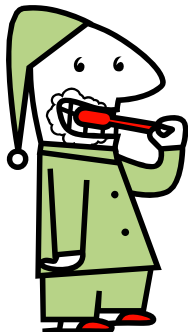

WHO ARE WE?

Our oral health service is staffed by a team of dedicated qualified dentists, dental therapists dental nurses and reception staff.

WHAT DO WE PROVIDE?

We can provide you with a range of dental services according to your individual needs, including:

- ◆ Emergency dental care (relief of pain)
- ◆ Check ups
- ◆ Preventative advice and treatments
- ◆ Cleaning
- ◆ Gum treatment
- ◆ Fillings
- ◆ Root canal treatments
- ◆ Extractions
- ◆ Full and partial dentures

Referrals to dental specialists can also be arranged if required. Waiting lists apply for general dental care and dentures for adults (over 18 years).

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Must be a resident of Victoria.

All children aged 0 - 12.

Young people aged 13 - 17 years who are health care or pensioner concession card holders.

All children up to the age of 18 years in residential care provided by Department of Human Services.

Patients over 18 years with current Health Care Card.

WHAT IS THE FEE?

CHILDREN

- ◆ The service is free for children aged 0 - 17 years if they are a dependent of a pension concession card or health care card holder.
- ◆ Or if your child is enrolled in a special or special development school.
- ◆ Children from 0 to 12 years who are dependants of non cardholders pay a fee of \$30 per child (maximum \$120 per family) per course of care which includes an examination (check up) and all general treatment.

PENSION CONCESSION CARD OR HEALTH CARE CARD HOLDERS OVER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN.

- ◆ For emergency appointments a \$25 fee applies
- ◆ For general course of care fees will range from \$25 - \$100
- ◆ Dentures and other specialist appointments will incur a separate fee.

DUTY OF CARE

We have a duty of care to treat you in a proper manner and we apply the same high standards as private dentists.

LATE FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT?

As you know it is difficult to get an appointment and the service is very busy. We cannot treat anyone who is more than 10 minutes late. Why?

A dentist has a duty of care to provide treatment to you and others in a manner that has your safety as its main aim. If you are late this compromises the ability to provide you with a safe treatment.

While we can empathize with why you are late we regret we cannot treat you.

In these situations you will be asked to reschedule.

WHAT TO DO IF RUNNING LATE?
